We enjoyed our stay at Stone Cottage. It is in a small and peaceful village in the Yonne and well positioned for sight seeing. Car parking is convenient (just make sure you get the short end of the ruelle, as it has a pinch point that won't accommodate cars so you can't get through if you approach from the top end). Tonnerre and Chatillon are equidistant for large supermarkets (about 20 mins drive I think from memory) and there's also a small supermarket in Laignes which is much closer.

The cottage itself is on three floors. The sitting room has two comfortable sofas and UK satellite service on the TV. The kitchen is well equipped (maybe a few more roasting type pans for the oven wouldn't go amiss but that's just being picky).

The garden is a beautiful little courtyard. There's a table and benches for sitting in the sun and the electrically operated sun canopy provides valuable shade on hot days. There is a small storage building that is home to a family of swallows. The babies leaned to fly while we were there and watching them swooping in and out was a joy.

There is a large bathroom and separate loo, plus two bedrooms on the first floor. The jacuzzi is a

nice luxury and there was always lots of hot water. The shower was excellent. The small single bedroom has no window but we weren't using this anyway. The double bedroom is a good size. On the top floor are two other bedrooms with velux windows. One is a single and the other another double. There's good storage space for clothes.

This part of Burgundy is beautiful and we spent one day sightseeing and the next relaxing in the cottage. Wifi was good on the whole although it was difficult to access at the top of the house (to be expected really). The kids found it cut out now and again but I didn't have a problem.

Laundry facilities were great, with a washing machine and tumble dryer.

Andrew, the owner, was always prompt in responding to any queries during the booking process and took action to deal with the issue we had with the dishwasher. He also paid our security deposit promptly after we returned.
